Job Description

Responsibilities

May include, but are not limited to, working at a service desk and assisting patrons; shelving books; retrieving materials from the stacks, receiving and processing books, films, journals and other materials; handling and cataloging materials; scanning materials; preparing packages for shipment and unpacking shipments; contributing to research projects; database maintenance; moving or shifting sizable quantities of books and/or other materials; film editing.

Oversight

Reports to Dawn Heckert and to Library Staff Supervisor for the area of assignment. Training will be provided and regular interaction with the supervisor.

- Ability to learn and apply policies and procedures consistently, accurately, and thoroughly.
- Attention to detail (especially in following routine processes).
- Ability to work well with a supervisor, individually, and as a team player.
- Effective oral communication skills.
- Highly reliable & punctual.
- Attentive, courteous, helpful and professional attitude while on duty.
- Ability to lift/carry 10 pounds
- Ability to reach high and low shelves and/or to use a step stool
- Basic computer literacy
- Aptitude for working with word processing, databases and other computer applications
- Film editing desirable for one project
