

Digital Scholarship Assistant Summer Library Internship

Job Description:

The Digital Scholarship team at Magill Library is looking for a student employee to help develop and manage web-based projects. Digital Scholarship hosts a variety of projects that require updating, customizing, and content management. This position will assist library staff with front-end and back-end development of projects based in Django, Omeka, Wordpress, and other web platforms. This is an excellent opportunity to engage with Digital Humanities and Digital Scholarship work while also gaining experience in web development, data management, and content management. Training for many of the required skills is available.

Responsibilities include:

- Web development for existing and new digital scholarship projects
- Assisting with web design and styling for projects
- Troubleshooting web services and managing Linux servers
- Assisting with building web exhibits and supporting course web sites
- Other duties as assigned

Oversight

The intern will report to Mike Zarafonitis, Coordinator for Digital Scholarship and Services, and Andy Janco, Digital Scholarship Librarian. Digital Scholarship staff will meet regularly with the student to provide advice and direction.

Qualifications:

- Experience with Python programming language
- Knowledge of HTML, PHP, Javascript, and/or CSS preferred
- Experience with content management systems (e.g. Wordpress, Drupal, Omeka) and writing content for the web preferred
- Experience with Linux operating system and command line preferred
- Effective writing skills
